

Should I apply to the Housing Executive?

If any of the statements apply to you (or anybody you live with) you should apply to the Housing Executive for help as homeless. The statement may apply to the place you live now or to another recent address that you lived in within the last two years, or longer in exceptional circumstances.

When filling in Question 3a of the 'General Housing Application Form' remember to include all of the statements you have ticked on this checklist.

Checklist

I do not have a roof over my head

I am living with friends or relatives and they want me to leave

I have suffered violence

I am in danger of violence where I am living

I have no legal right to occupy my accommodation

For example, you are occupying property after the legal owner has died or moved away

It isn't reasonable for me to live in the property anymore.

For example, it is overcrowded, it is dangerous to your health, it is too expensive, relationship breakdown

I am living a B&B or a hostel

I cannot get into my accommodation.

for example, your landlord has locked you out

My landlord has told me to leave my accommodation

My home is being repossessed because of mortgage arrears

My home is tied to my job which I have left or about to leave
